Course location / Description: The course is run at Te Teko racecourse, through the surrounding parkland.

The Venue is Te Teko racecourse, Hogbin Road, Te Teko, parking is available on site.

Facilities: The venue has toilets on site. On the day entries will be on site.

Prize-giving: Presentations will be held at the venue, after the completion of the final event, no later than 3.30pm.

Eligibility: To be eligible for an Athletics Waikato BOP championship placing, athletes (including masters' grades) must be registered as a competitive athlete with Athletics Waikato-Bay of Plenty. **Social registered and non-registered (unaffiliated) athletes may compete but are ineligible for Athletics Waikato Bay of Plenty championship placing or medals. Child athletes are to note that you must have registered for the new season starting April 2018 to be eligible for the Championships, your previous summer membership from last season will have now expired.**

Grades: Where races are combined, the grades will be separated in the results.

Ages: Masters Ages are on the day, with results recorded in 5-year age groups from 35 years plus. All other age grades are age at 31st December 2018.

Closing date: Entries are to be made online by 14th July. **All entries after 14th July will be \$5.00 extra per person and must be made on the day.** There will be no refund of entries after the early entry closing date.
